AMA Road Captain Workshop	<p>The AMA Road Captain Workshop was developed in 2017 to offer AMA members and clubs the opportunity to discuss best practices for successfully and safely leading a group ride.</p> <p>The workshop is exclusively for AMA members and is typically offered in the spring and fall of each year at the AMA Motorcycle Hall of Fame Museum in Pickerington, Ohio. It averages 1 hour in length. Topics include planning the route, paperwork, emergency preparedness and response, hand signals, actions during the ride and more.</p>	Heather Wilson	<p>Heather Wilson is the Recreational Riding Manager at the American Motorcyclist Association. She works with AMA-chartered organizers to coordinate both on- and off-road riding activity. She grew up immersed in motorcycling, with her dad owning motorcycle dealership in Ohio for 40 years and the family frequently camping and riding together. She currently rides a KTM Freeride 250R dirt bike and a KTM 690 Duke street bike.</p> <p>She holds a Bachelor of Science in Journalism from Ohio University, with specializations in public relations and marketing, as well as a minor in organizational communications. She is also a motorcycle safety instructor and volunteers with a local race series.</p>
Paint Your Own	Bring your favorite beverage and a can do attitude for some fun in the afternoon. We will be crafting a painting that's just the right size for you to take home in your saddlebags.	Wrae Wene	Wrae is a practicing artist and a fine art educator with 30 years experience. She exhibits her mixed media paintings in the Baltimore metropolitan area.
Inspect Your Own Motorcycle	Are you planning to buy a motorcycle and there is an inspection in your near future? Do you want to give your ride a full run-through to make sure it's ready for the road? Save the trip, pocket that \$120 and verify the safety of your bike on your own. We will go over the basics of how to check the components on your motorcycle just like an inspection station would. The Baltimore Motorcycle Collective wants to help you take control of your motorcycle maintenance. The workshop is limited to 10 hands on participants but no limit to how many can watch and listen.	Ethan Pritchard	About our presenter - Ethan operates the Baltimore Motorcycle Collective, a DIY Community Garage in Canton in Baltimore City. After graduating from University of Maryland, he moved back to Baltimore and no longer had a garage. He knows a lot of people don't have garage space in Baltimore so he opened The Collective to allow people to work on their own stuff with all the fun tools someone with a garage would have, and then some.
Biker Yoga	Biker Yoga is designed to teach safe, bike-assisted poses for roadside stops. She will teach ways to stretch and move parts of the biker body which often get sore, tired, and overused during rides: hips, lower back, calves, ankles, wrists and shoulders.
